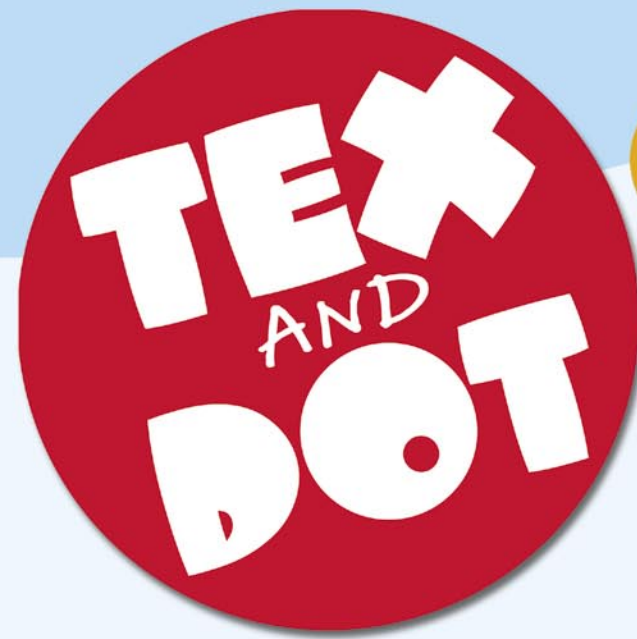

How to play the CLEAN AIR CREW CARD GAME (For 2 players)

Using safety scissors (or with help from a grown-up), carefully cut out the Drive Clean Across Texas cards. Mix them up and deal three cards. Stack the remaining cards in one stack, face down, between the players.

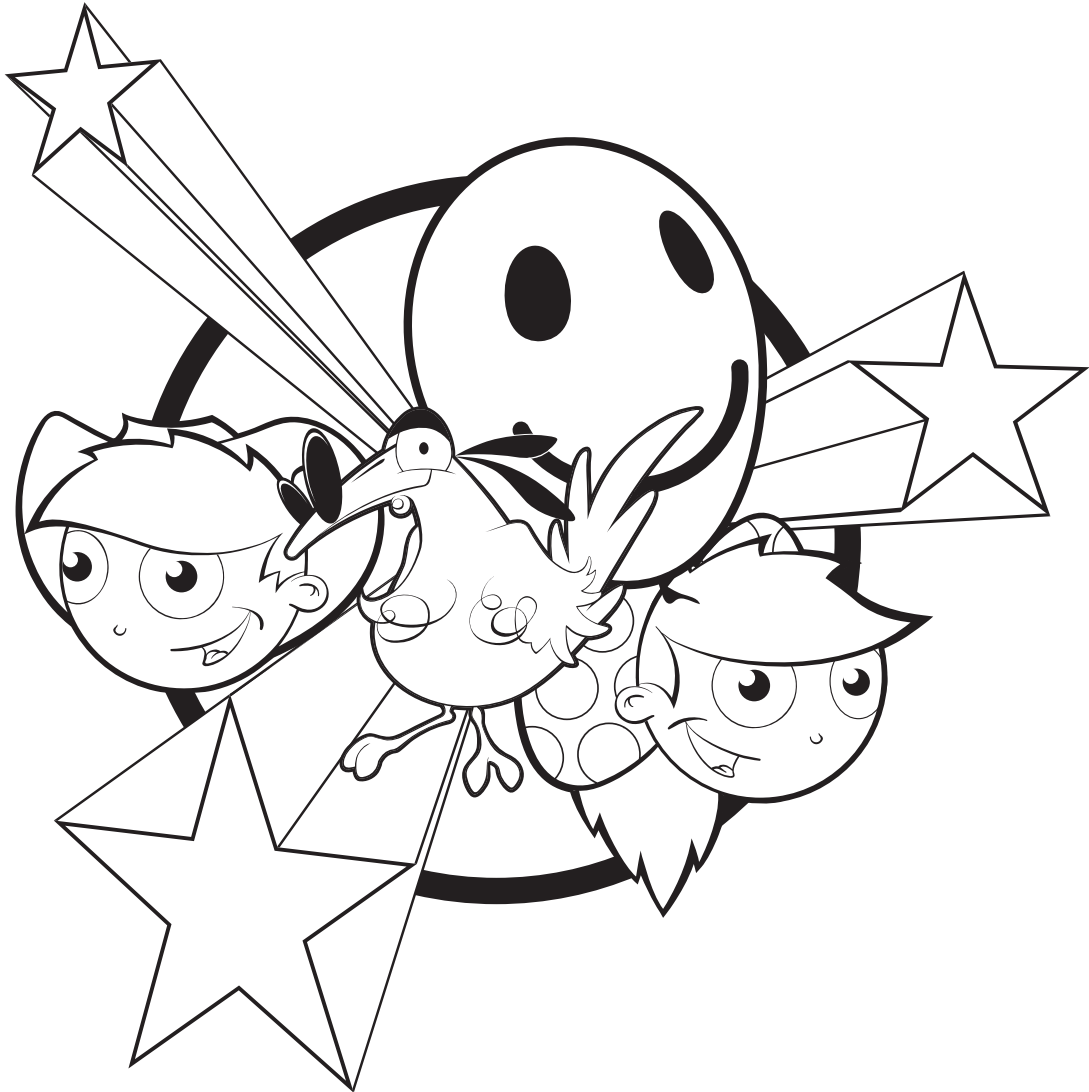
The goal is to match the cards in each player's hand, much like "Go Fish." Player 1 asks player 2 for a matching card, and vice versa. If no match can be found, the player asking for the card must say, "Drive Clean Across Texas!" and draw one card from the middle stack. If a pair is made, either by drawing a card or getting a match from the other player, the paired cards are set aside.

Play ends when a player uses all of their cards. The player with the most pairs of matched cards is declared the winner.

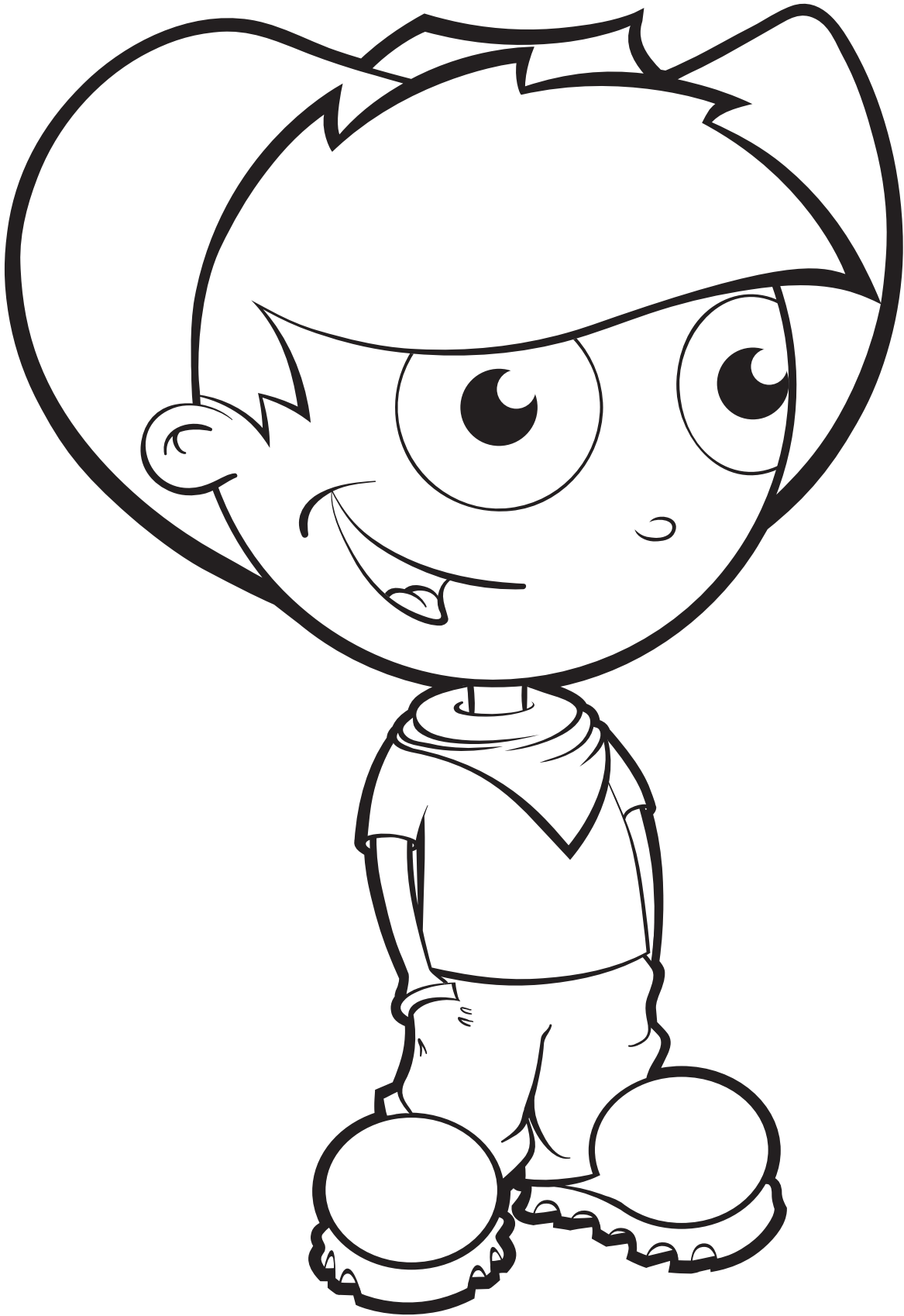

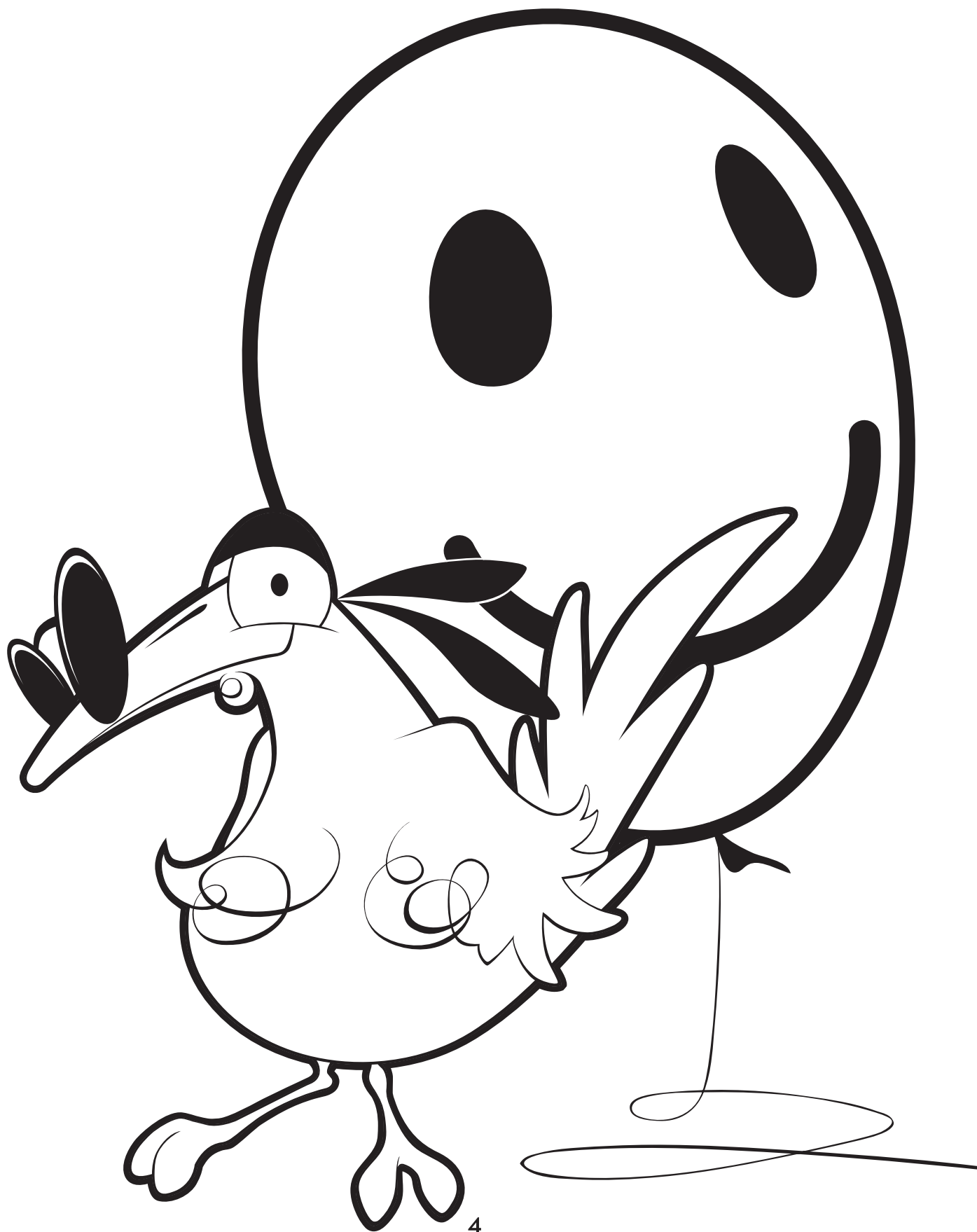
Hi everyone! I'm TEX.



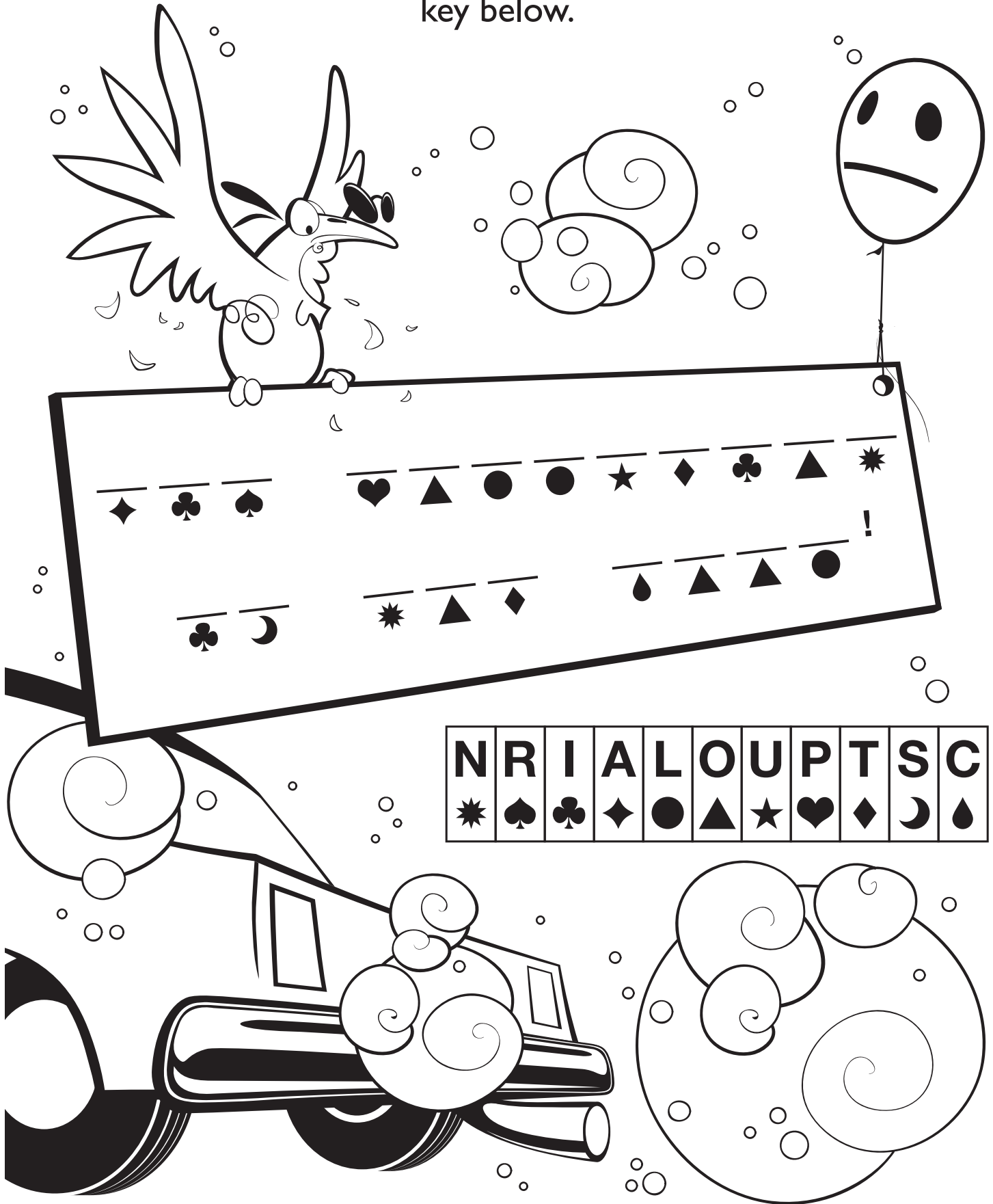
I'm DOT. We like to help teach kids about transportation and how it affects the world around us.

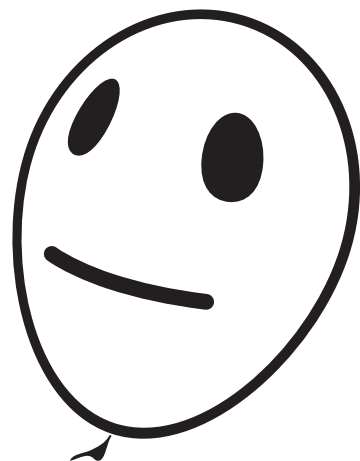


Color Ollie to match how he feels.



GREEN Ollie is happy in the air, because the skies around are *clean* and *fair*.

Air Quality Index = 0 - 50



YELLOW means there is cause for concern, and Ollie's lungs may have a *little burn*.

Air Quality Index = 51 - 100

ORANGE is Ollie's mood when the air becomes even *more crude*.

Air Quality Index = 101 - 150



RED Ollie is downright sad when the ozone is *really bad*!

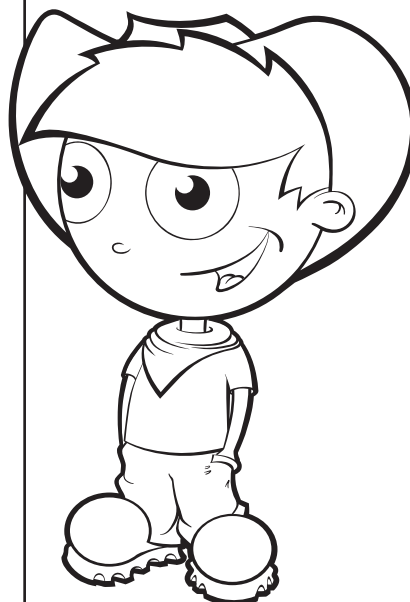
Air Quality Index = 151 - 200

PURPLE means you absolutely cannot go out, and Ollie gives us a *super pout*!

Air Quality Index = 201+



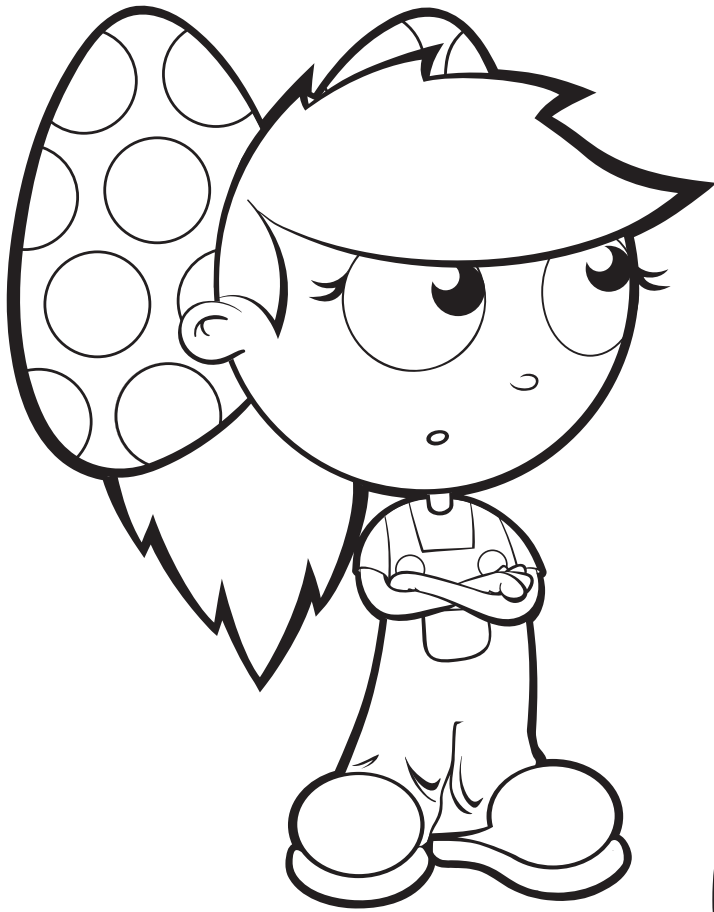

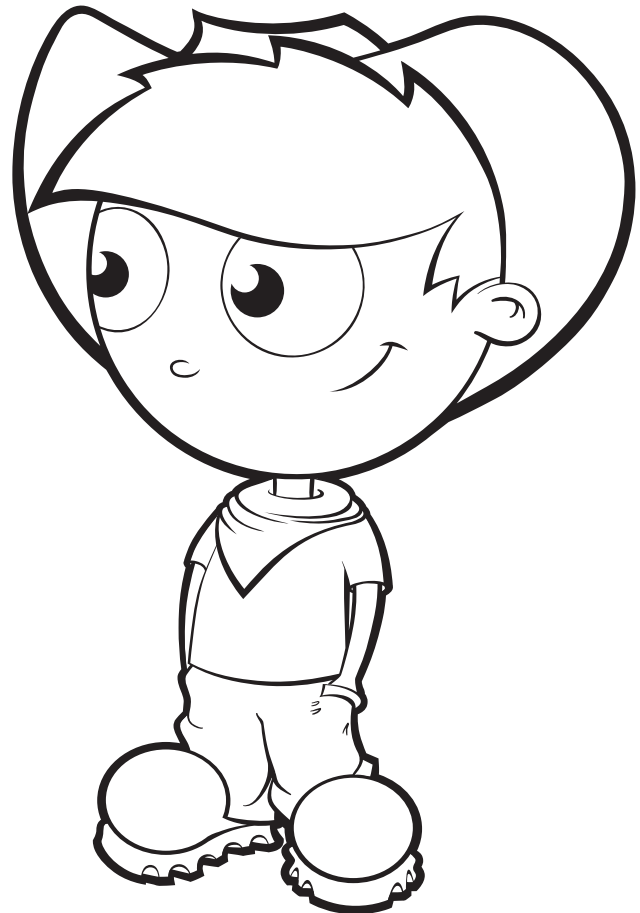
The faster we drive our cars, the more we pollute. Slow down!

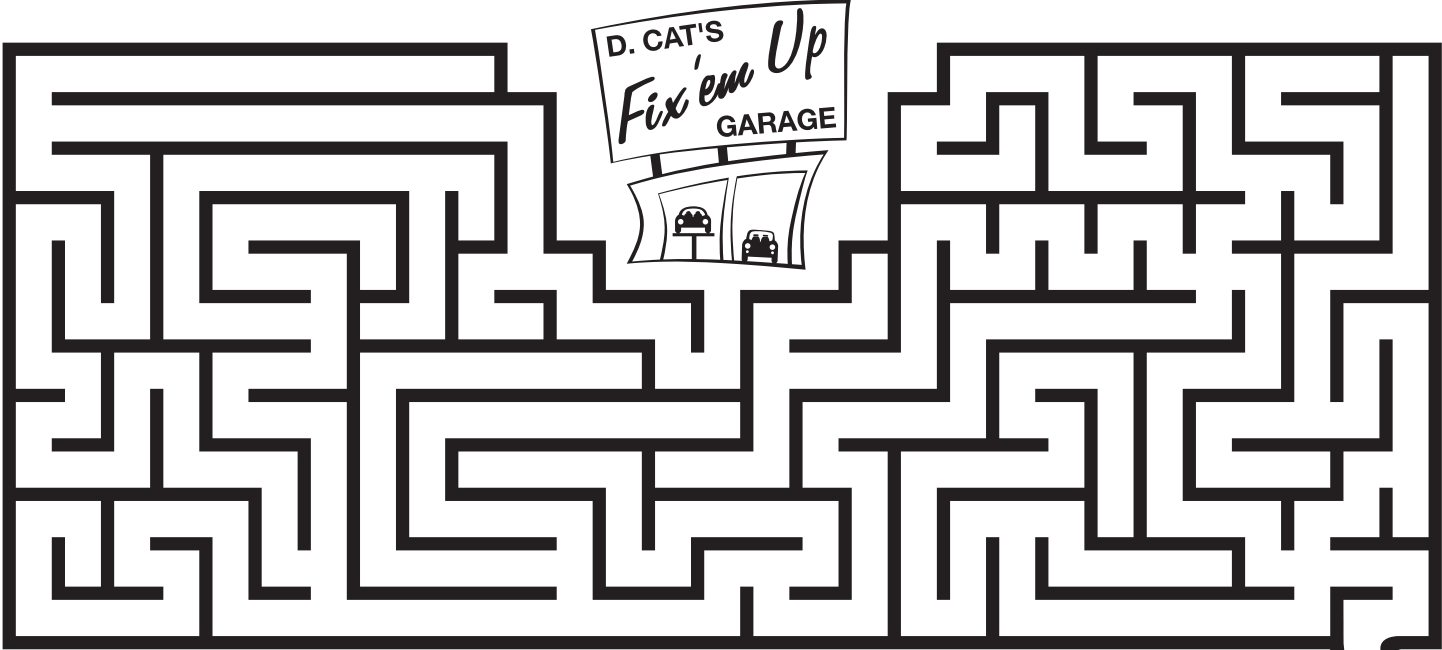

When a car's engine runs well, it does not pollute as much.

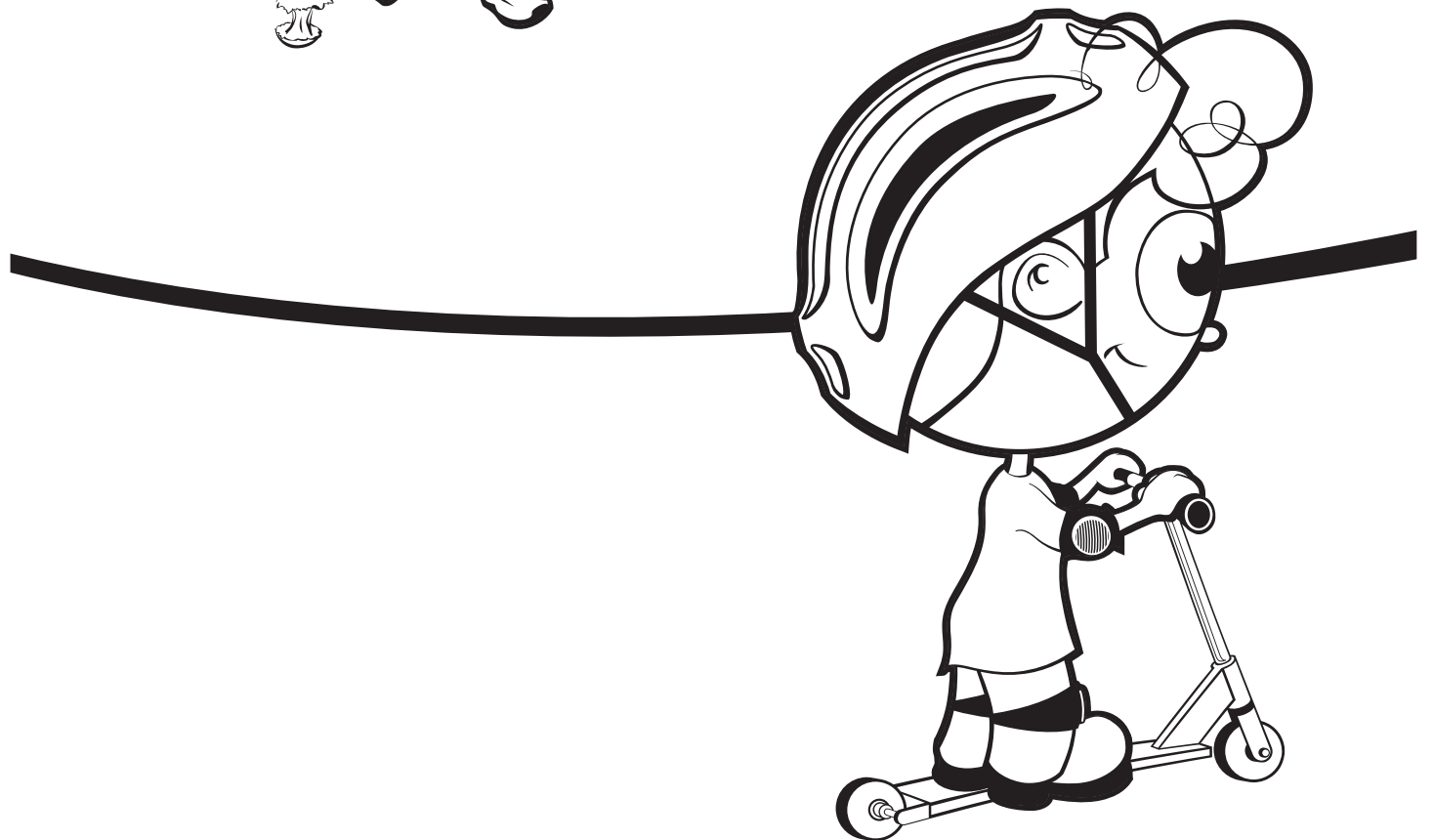


Black, stinky smoke means your car is sick. How can we help make sure our family car's engine is not sick? Help guide Tex's family car through the maze. It really needs a mechanic!

In the picture, circle ways we can get around without driving.

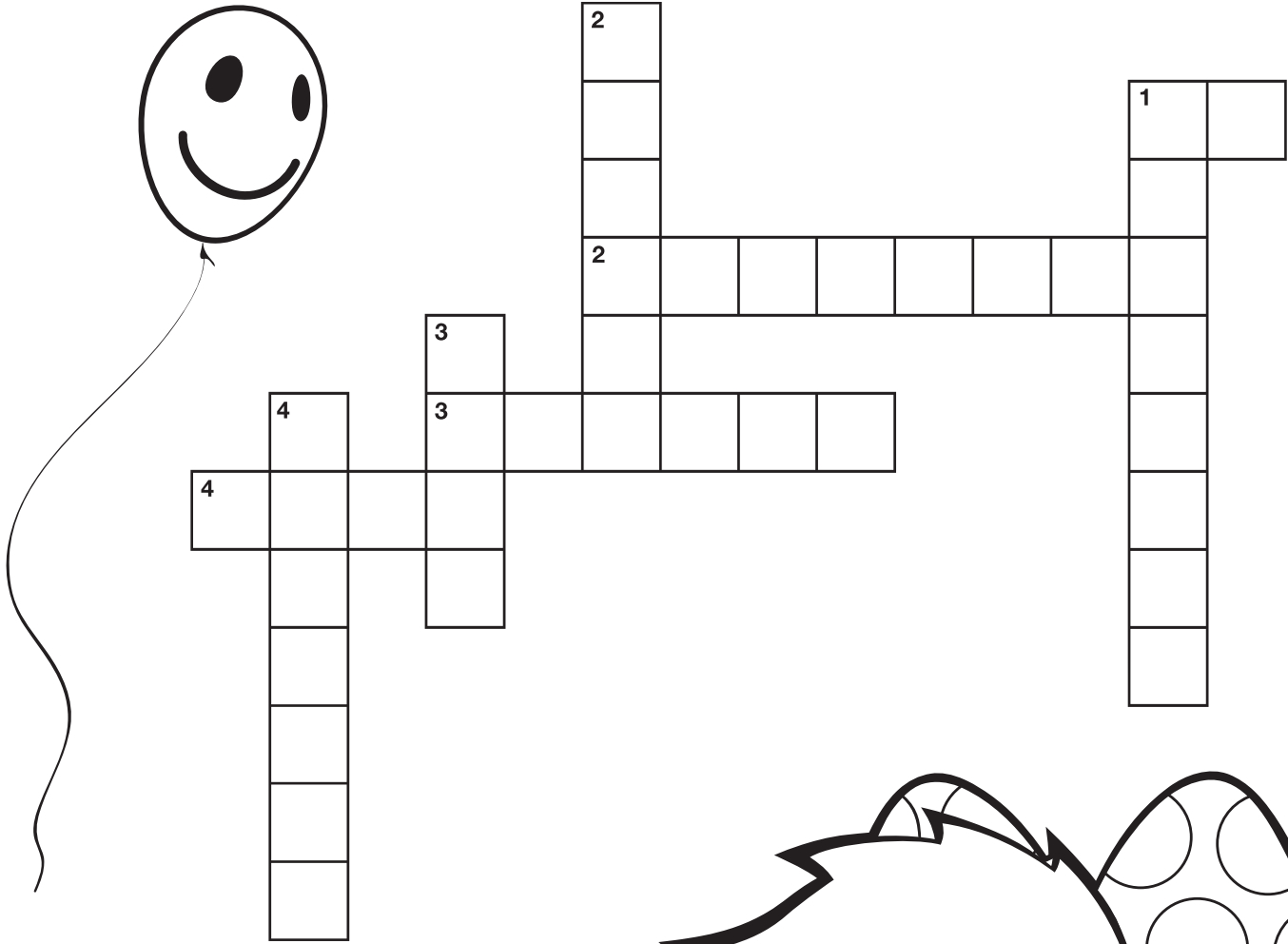




Idling engines pollute. Tell everyone to turn off the engine, or park the car and walk inside.



We can all do things to help prevent air pollution. To find out what, fill in the blanks and solve the crossword puzzle.

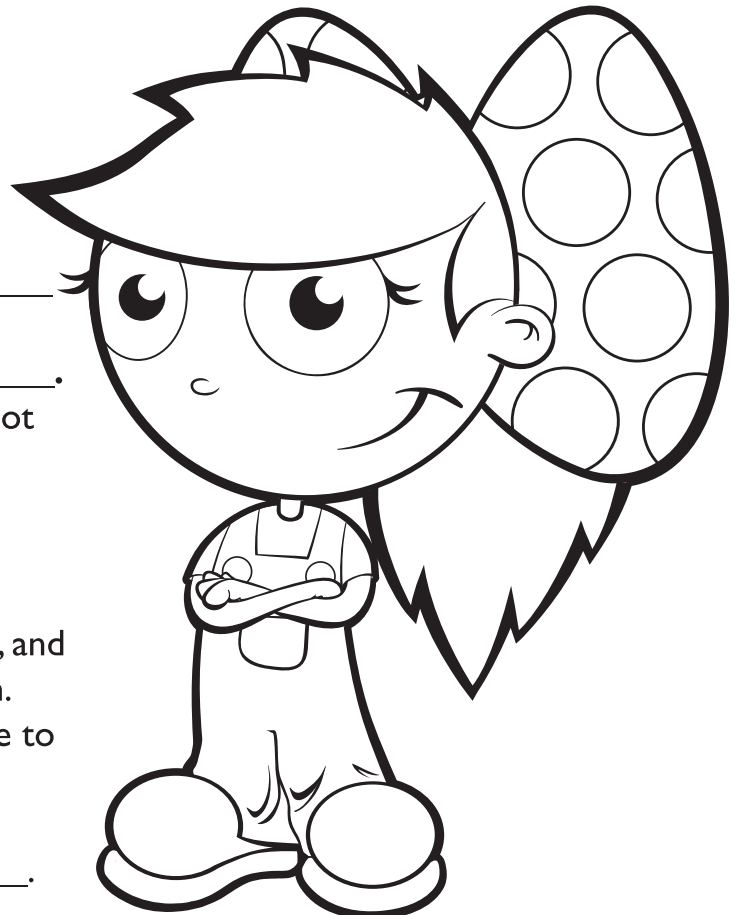
