Center is situated in the heart of the Haynesville Shale and there is a large amount of locally produced natural gas that is available for either heat or power co-generation purposes.



There are large tracts of undeveloped land near and around the City that would be condusive to industrial development.

The City of Center has an expedited and hasslefree permitting process. And, the City's water supply is stable to support another food processing business.



The new Loop 500 expansion project will open up land for development.

Finally, Center is located on US 96, which runs through East Texas and is 15 miles from US 59, the future I-69.
