Center, Texas, located in the East Texas Piney Woods, has a business friendly environment where investor risk can be greatly reduced.

This is possible because of Center's geographic location in relation to severe weather events, the City's actions to reduce the ISO rating, our air

quality attainment status, the lack of labor unions, and our hassle-free permitting process.



Center is located in Zone C for property insurance purposes. This means that Center is far enough away from the Gulf of Mexico that there is little property damage sustained from tropical storms and hurricanes. Center is also far

enough south where we are not effected by tornadoes, hail storms and winter blasts. This directly translates into lower property insurance rates.

The City of Center recently embarked on an ambitous program to lower the ISO rating from a 4. After purchasing a 75 foot ladder truck, the City's ISO rating was reduced to a 3. The City

is seeking ways to even further improve this rating.



Noartainment and Near Noartainment Areas

Shelby County is located in an air quality attainment area. This means that there are fewer air quality regulations and costs that are borne by the company. There are also no additional air quality regulations

imposed by the City or the County.

There are no active labor unions operating in Shelby County. This can give businesses the confidence that there will not be any labor disruptions in their operations.

Finally, the City of Center prides itself on having a hassle-free permitting process. The City has taken the position that it will be a partner with local business when it comes to their permitting needs. All permits are handled at our one-stop office.
