Center, Texas, located in the East Texas Piney Woods, is home to one of the most skilled manufacturing workforces in the State of Texas and comes at a premium

This does not mean that our workforce is cheap. Center would not possess a growing industrial base if that were so. Tyson Foods recently completed a \$25 million plant expansion and created nearly 200 new jobs. Other industrial citizens are: Port-A-Cool, Hallmark - Center Fixture Operations, General Shelters, Ameri-Tech/Steel Building Supply.

Panola College is a key partner in training our local workforce. The Shelby County Center offers general academic classes and Panola operates the Shelby Regional Training Center, which offers vocational training in areas such as welding, electrical, motor control, GIS, and petroleum technology.

Panola works with local industry to customize training programs. Micro-Seismic, an energy industry service company, chose to locate in Center because of a customized training program.

Location quotients (LQ) indicate the relative strength of an area's workforce. Shelby County's forte is manufacturing. Shelby County boasts a 3.39 LQ in manufacturing, the 5th largest in the State of Texas.

The unemployment rate in Shelby County closely tracks that of the State of Texas.
